The Impact of Inequality on Property Taxation in Norway

The paper

What is the relationship between economic inequality and the property tax paid for a standard house?

- Collect data on fiscal, political, demographic and inequality characteristics of Norwegian municipalities
- Estimate fixed effect model to study role of inequality in determining property taxes paid
- No relationship with income inequality but positive association with wealth inequality

Ideas for further exploration/clarification

1. Separate variation in property taxed paid into price effects vs changes in tax rates

Is the finding confounded by relationship between inequality and price or policy changes?

What are their elasticities?

Ideas for further exploration/clarification

- 2. Derive testable implications based on a theoretical relationship between inequality and property taxes
- What are the common and idiosyncratic drivers of changes in property taxes and inequality? Labor market shocks? Mobility? Asset price changes?
- What happens to municipal spending as property tax collections increase? Unaffected? More redistributive spending?
